

RESOLUTION NO. 1983-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA  
PUBLIC POWER AUTHORITY REGARDING  
ALLOCATION OF GENERAL EXPENSES

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 1982-30 adopted October 6, 1982, the Southern California Public Power Authority (Authority) provided for allocation of the general expenses of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, said resolution provided that the general expenses of the Authority be allocated to the funded projects in the same ratio as Los Angeles' estimated direct charges of a funded project bear to Los Angeles' total estimated direct charges for all funded projects; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, general expenses were apportioned 25 percent to the Mead-Phoenix Project and 75 percent to the Palo Verde Project for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1983; and

WHEREAS, said resolution also provides that the Board review the allocation based upon actual direct charges of Los Angeles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

- (1) That the Board finds that the actual charges do not vary substantially from the estimated charges and no adjustment of the allocation is necessary for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1983.
- (2) That the allocation for general expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1984, shall be 21 percent to the Mead-Phoenix Project and 79 percent to the Palo Verde Project until such time as another Authority project becomes funded at which time the allocation shall be refigured based on Los Angeles' estimated direct charges.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION is approved and adopted by the Authority this sixth day of July 1983.

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
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
